May 13, 2019 - As part of the Experience North summer internship program, Northern Policy Institute (NPI) has welcomed five new summer placements located in the communities of Sudbury, Timmins and Kenora.

Every year, in collaboration with partners across Northern Ontario, NPI gives young professionals a unique opportunity to experience public policy development by working on projects that will contribute to the sustainable growth and enhanced resiliency of Northern Ontario communities.

Summer placements are given a topic to research and identify policy opportunities. This year's topics include identifying and collecting appropriate statistics to examine housing affordability and accessibility in Northern Ontario, verifying and updating NPI's data catalogues related to our research areas such as demographics, Indigenous peoples, and economy. As well, the interns will use labour market information to examine job vacancies and projections. Other projects involve assessing the economic impact of international students and identifying areas of convergence and divergence in some Northern Ontario communities.
