



## Marketing Placement – Graphic Designer

Northern Policy Institute (NPI) is seeking one (1) full-time Summer Marketing Placement – Graphic Designer for a 16 week placement with a host organization in **Parry Sound**. While individuals with particular expertise are most welcome, an interdisciplinary approach and the capacity to work across platforms and functions is expected and required.

The placement will focus on graphic design work including creation of graphics and video for social media and web as well as the layout of internal and external publications. The successful candidate will work as a part of the communications and marketing team to design, produce and disseminate NPI publications, marketing and events materials and other promotional items.

Experience with social media would be a decided asset. Experience working with Adobe InDesign and other Creative Cloud programs is critical to the nature of the placement. Bilingualism would be an advantage. Multilingualism, or a special knowledge of Northern Ontario would also be assets.

Only candidates who are currently studying at a post-secondary level and intend to return to school in the fall of 2019 are eligible to apply for this position. **Candidates must provide a one paragraph statement as to why they have applied for the position in this specific community. Applications that do not include this information will not be considered.**

Northern Policy Institute appreciates all expressions of interest; only candidates who are to be interviewed will be contacted. The salary range for this position is \$16-\$18 per hour. Internships will begin May 6, 2019 and end August 23, 2019.

Deadline for applications is **January 31, 2019**.
