Covid19 - Where do we go from here

NPI analysis underway:

- Current Impact: Northerners likely to fall through cracks, FN response, Social Networks in the North
- Future Trends: historical recovery patterns and whether they apply, international students – expect a drop, ICT gaps laid bare

Suggestions for NOHFC:

- Bigger internship program, longer placements
- o Fill the gap in service, international students to immigrants
- NFPs will need extra help in 2020-2021
