
What is Northern Policy Institute?

Household Incomes


Incomes in Northeastern and Northwestern Ontario are below provincial and national averages

Market income as a percentage of total income


Northern Ontario trails Ontario and Canada; Decline in 2020

Labour Force Participation Rate


Lower LF participation in Northern Ontario


Lower employment rate in Northern Ontario


Population increased in 7 census divisions, decreased in 4


Demographic Dependency Ratio


Youth employment – Traditional DDR likely more accurate for NO


Demographic Dependency Ratio



Migration in Northeast


Over the past 5 years, net migration has been positive



Perceived physical health


Across Northern Ontario, perceived health is worse than in Ontario and Canada as a whole


Perceived mental health is similar across geographies

Crime Severity Index


Crime severity index is above the provincial average in each of the "Big Five" Northern Ontario cities


Individuals in Thunder Bay and Sudbury are more likely to report a strong sense of belonging to their local community
