



First Nation, Metis, Inuit & Francophone

A Hiring Preference

When considering applications from two equally qualified candidates, NPI will give preference to First Nation, Métis, Inuit, or Francophone candidates.

Candidates coming from rural or remote northern communities or with a stated interest in working in northern regions in the future will also be given special preference.

If any of these characteristics apply to you, we encourage you to voluntarily state this in your cover letter.

Bilingual Students

A Top-Up in Pay

Northern Policy Institute values the ability to engage with the community in both official languages.

For 12-month internships and annual contracts

 An increment of \$2,000 over and above base salary is available for those who can fluently speak both French and English in a professional setting.

For 4-month placements or co-op positions

An increment of \$500 over and above base salary is available for those who can fluently speak both French and English in a professional setting.

Pay & Benefits

12-Month Placements

- Salary \$39,130 per year
- 2% RRSP (no matching required)
- \$500 professional development allowance
- 2 weeks vacation per year plus 2 weeks with pay at Christmas

Co-ops and Internships

- \$18-20 per hour for Bachelor or College level candidates
- \$20-22 per hour for Master level candidates
- 2% RRSP (no matching required)
- 4% accrual paid out in lieu of vacation for placements less than 4 months, taken as paid vacation for periods in excess of 4 months
